

NOMINATION FOR THE PROVINCIAL FOUNDING MEMBER AWARD 2009



CRITERIA FOR SELECTION:

1. The RTO/ERO Founding Member Award is presented to an RTO/ERO member in recognition of outstanding voluntary contributions to the work of RTO/ERO **at the provincial level**.
2. No more than one Award is presented per year.
3. To retain the prestige associated with the Award, its presentation is at the discretion of the Provincial Executive, not necessarily on an annual basis.
4. Current/Past Presidents and Executive Directors are not eligible to be nominated for the Founding Member Award.
5. RTO/ERO members who are still actively serving in any capacity at the Provincial level are not eligible for nomination for the Founding Member Award.

PROCEDURES:

1. Districts are invited to submit a nominee, on the prescribed Nomination Form, to Diane Simpson, Administrative Assistant – Executive, at the Provincial Office by mail, email – dsimpson@rto-ero.org or by completing the online application at the RTO/ERO website – <http://www.rto-ero.org>
2. Nominations previously submitted do not carry over to the next year; however, a District may resubmit a nomination if it wishes.
3. A candidate for receipt of the Award is chosen by the Provincial Executive.
4. The Award is presented at the Annual Senate Meeting dinner.
5. The Award consists of
 - a) a framed certificate, and
 - b) a donation of \$500 to the charitable organization of the recipient's choice.
6. Nominations must reach the Provincial Office no later than **June 1**.
